New Baltimore Farmers' Market Celebrates Fathers on June 20

After a delightful opening day, the New Baltimore Farmers' Market season next unfolds with special pre-Father's Day festivities on June 20 including a Pegasus Restaurant chef demonstrating grilling and a Milk Celebration sponsored by the Girl Scouts. Fathers will receive free "Market Mugs" (as long as they last) and can enter a special "Fathers Only" raffle of gift certificates donated by local business owners. Activities for the youngsters will include making a cow puppet and a simple ice cream recipe.

The Market offers local produce, herbs, eggs, meat, honey, beeswax, artisanal breads, baked goods, salad dressings, flowering plants, woodcrafts and ready-to-eat handmade foods. Free organic coffee will always be available.

Come support Town farmers and local agriculture and find fresh, locally grown food and crafted products in a lovely spot where neighbors from all our hamlets can gather. Look at a community bulletin board, a website and a community resource table of the talents, services and events available in our Town and County. And support local food pantries to assure that fresh produce can be included in the pantries' offerings.

The New Baltimore Farmers' Market will be held every Saturday now until October 31st from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. The Market is located at the Town's Wyche/District 1 Park on New Baltimore Road, which runs between Routes 9W and 144 just south of Ravena.
