  - o Bracelets will be issued to all patrons over the age of 21.
  - o Tom Frese has been secured as caterer for a chicken dinner venue @ \$8.50/meal.
  - Dinner seating's will be at 5:30, 6:30 and 7:30. Seating's will be 40 patrons each.
  - o Jeff and Joy to secure a Porta-Potty and sink rental.
  - o Jeff and Chris Norris to inquire into the acquisition of tables and chairs.
  - Joyce will look into acquiring the tents.
  - o Dick will contact Boehm's Farm for apple and cider supplies.
  - o Chris Byas will take care of corn stalks.
  - Approved volunteers shall be given free meals for their efforts.
  - On Sept. 12, @ 10:00, the NBBC committee shall meet at the Hilscher Farm for a walkthrough and final planning time for the event.
  - In light of the magnitude of planning and physical effort needed for this event, it is requested that committee members please make themselves available to assist. (Begging, borrowing and pleading for extra volunteer helping hands are officially sanctioned by the NBBC.)
  - Chris Norris to look into door prizes.
  - o 50/50 tickets to be sold.
  - All profits from this event shall be applied to The New Baltimore Bicentennial Celebration in 2011.

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- Jeff will follow up with the Greene Co. Promotions Dept. by submitting an official letter from the NBBC on seeking funding from the county for the town 2011 celebrations. It has been suggested to c.c. Legislators / Representatives Mr. Jim Van Slyke and Mr. Wayne Speenburgh as additional resources.
- Clesson has volunteered to contact all committee members in the event meetings should be cancelled or rescheduled.
- Recording Subcommittee:
