Supervisor Louis called the public hearing to order at 7:30 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was said. Also attending: Councilwoman McKeon, Councilmen Kuenster, Norris, and Byas, Town Clerk Brooks, and 4 members of the public. Absent: Highway Superintendent Jordan and Tax Collector Stuart.

Supervisor stated that the purpose of this Local Law was to establish a new schedule of real property tax exemptions for persons sixty-five years of age or over and for persons with disabilities and limited incomes. There is a slight change in original draft distributed several weeks prior; Section 1 now includes the New York State legislative authority for the exemption. Raising the income threshold for the 50% tax exemption from \$18,000 to \$19,500 accommodates Town residents' Social Security benefits increase for 2009; at the top end of the income scale, \$26,899.99 has been increased to \$27,899.99. All the other provisions from 2008 are retained in the Local Law 3 for 2009.

Supervisor opened the floor for public comment. Hearing none, Councilwoman McKeon moved to close the public hearing, seconded by Councilman Norris.
