RESOLUTION TO APPROVE EMERGENCY PURCHASE FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS the Town Board adopted its Procurement Policy on January 1, 2014 concerning the procurement of goods and services.

WHEREAS, Chief Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Jim Polverelli determined that the Isco Flow Meter that records the flow through the plant required a new probe and this part was necessary to stay in compliance with New York State Department of Environmental Conservation regulations.

WHEREAS due to the emergency condition of this repair and according to Procurement Policy 6 b. Section 103 (4) of the General Municipal Law, this service had to be performed immediately and an alternative proposal might threaten the life, health, safety or welfare of the residents.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of New Baltimore approves said emergency probe from Corrosion Products, Invoice No. 86209 for \$1,111.75.
